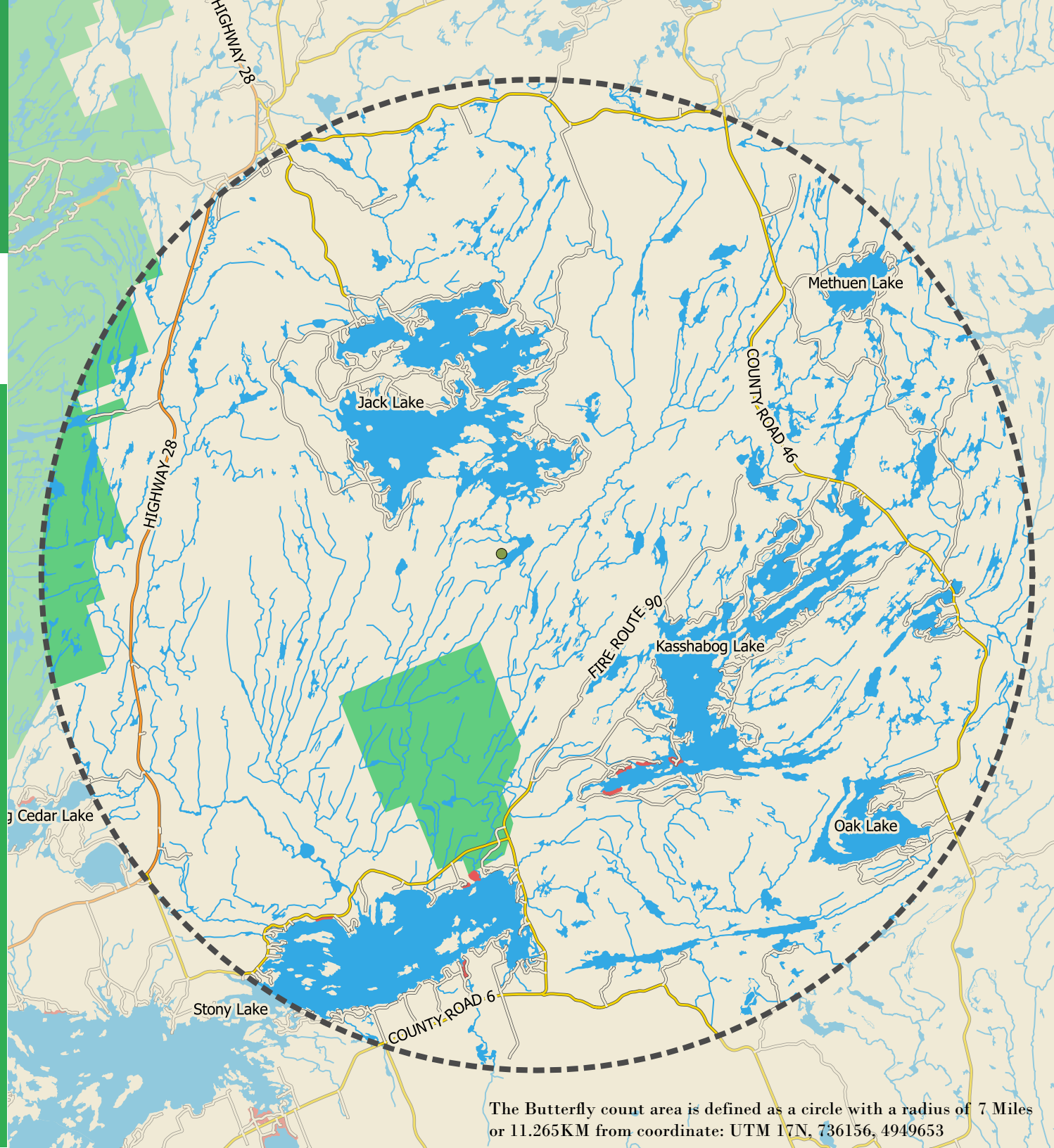

The Butterfly count area is defined as a circle with a radius of 7 Miles or 11.265KM from coordinate: UTM 17N, 736156, 4949653
