

## **Application for Peterborough Field Naturalist Legacy Grant**

The Peterborough Field Naturalist (PFN) Legacy Grant was created to support individuals in enhancing the naturalist community or natural environment in Peterborough and the Kawarthas. These grants would not be possible without the generous bequests and donations from our members. This year we are able to offer a limited number of grants up to \$300 each. Each application will be reviewed by our selection committee. Please attach any supporting documents such as letters of permission if your project is to alter public land.

### **Eligibility:**

PFN Legacy Grants are to be awarded to an individual or non-profit group for the purposes of completing projects or research that:

1. Enhance understanding of nature through education or research
2. Restore or conserve habitat through stewardship or restoration

The objectives of the PFN Legacy Fund Grant Program align with the PFN motto:  
*“To know, appreciate, and conserve nature in all its forms”*

When a grant is awarded it is requested that:

- Projects are completed within 8 months.
- Upon completion a short project report is submitted to our monthly bulletin, “The Orchid” with pictures if possible.

### **Eligible Costs:**

Grants may be used to cover project expenses such as supporting volunteer involvement, material costs, printing, data analysis, field equipment or supplies. Overhead expenses such as payroll or salary are not eligible.
